| First session | £50 |
| Includes medical questionnaire, analysis of the cause of the injury, any investigations by your general practitioner. An examination to determine the cause of the injury, followed by the treatment, and any constructive exercise plan. The first session sets the basis of any future treatments and any agreed action plan. Clients should allow 1 to 2 hours for this session. During the initial examination if it proves necessary to refer you to a specialist, we will talk you through your injury at no cost. With J-Jaz Services and Training you only pay for the treatment – talking is free. | |

- No responsibility is taken for injury, illness or death unless the same is caused directly by the negligence of your therapist.

- The answers in your medical questionnaire shall be truthful, comprehensive, and you will not withhold any material fact to the best of your ability and knowledge.
 - A cancellation charge of £10 will be applied, if an appointment is cancelled within 24 hours of the treatment appointment. Appointments can be re-scheduled with appropriate notice at no extra charge.
 - The therapist has the right to refuse treatment without explanation if he/she deems treatment may be detrimental to your health or safety.
 - Treatment will not be carried out until any outstanding payments are received from previous treatments or cancellation charges.
 - Treatments should not normally last more than 45 minutes, except in the case of multiple muscles requiring massage.

Your Rights.

The client may refuse treatment and/or halt treatment at any time.

The client may request and is entitled that another person be present during treatment.
